Speaker Marg Produe spoke about the "I" in the LGBTQ+ community. Marg is a person living with intersex traits. Marg spoke about her life as an intersex person with candor, kindness and a bit of good humor. She is married and has 4 adult children. Her story is deeply moving and informative. We learned that about 2% of the



population has intersex traits. Intersex people are as common as redheads. Many of these individuals never know they are intersex unless there is a problem. Marg holds multiple degrees and is a member of interACT, InterConnect, Madison Area Transgender Association, Oconomowoc PFLAG, The River City Gems, Transgender Heaven and Crossdresser Heaven. Marg also volunteers for Pride and Pridefest along with attending conventions for InterConnect, Keystone, Diva Las Vegas, Wildside and BeAll.
