Lane Hanson, Director of Finance and Development for the Gay/Straight Alliance for Safe Schools (GSAFE) was the speaker for our March meeting. Lane is a long time Madison resident who spoke about how GSAFE is working to address systemic disparities that are pervasive in our community. Her role at GSAFE involves securing financing for grassroots organizing efforts that will ultimately make life better for queer and trans identified youth across Wisconsin. GSAFE's mission is to create just schools for LGBTQ+ youth in Wisconsin by 1) developing the leadership of LGBTQ+ youth (Leadership Training Institute camp), 2) supporting Gay-Straight Alliances, 3) training educators, 4) advancing educational justice and 5) deepening racial, gender, trans, and social justice. Lane spoke about her personal experience as a member of the community and is the proud parent of two thriving young adults who have benefited from GSAFE programming.
